HOME / LONDON

LONDON

Day 2 | Set out with a private guide to uncover the character of your neighborhood, from storied streets to hidden gems like Neal's Yard or Shepherd Market. Continue through Clerkenwell and Farringdon, exploring historic pubs rich with lore. Conclude with a classic pie and pint, a warm taste of British culture.



LONDON

Day 3 | Step inside royal tradition at Windsor Castle, guided by an expert, where centuries of ceremony and history unfold. Back in the East End, streets of Spitalfields and Shoreditch reveal layered cultures and bold flavors. Along the way, be entranced with tastes of iconic bites shaped by generations of immigrants, from bagels to fish ‘n’ chips.



LONDON

Day 4 | Spend a personally guided day in the Cotswolds, where rolling countryside and honey-stone villages create a distinctly English backdrop. Visit Burford and Woodstock, pause for a relaxed pub lunch, then continue to Stow-on-the-Wold and Bourton-on-the-Water, each offering its own quiet charm and character.



LONDON

Day 5 | Drift along the Thames on a private boat, where London’s skyline gives way to quieter, storied corners. Beneath the city, the Churchill War Rooms reveal the tension and resolve of wartime Britain, from the preserved map room to Churchill’s private quarters and hidden communications hub.



LONDON / YORK

Day 6 | Travel north in a first-class rail carriage, where attentive service and a relaxed pace set the tone for the journey. On arrival, a private transfer brings you to your centrally located hotel within a landmark former railway building. YORK

YORK / EDINBURGH

Day 8 | Begin the morning exploring York's enduring chocolate legacy, from artisan creations to hands-on experiences, before wandering the Shambles, where medieval architecture and lively shops line its narrow, cobbled street. Later, continue north in a first-class rail carriage to Edinburgh, where a seamless private transfer awaits to your luxury hotel.

EDINBURGH

Day 9 | Wander Edinburgh's Old Town with a private guide, where centuries of history unfold along the Royal Mile and through hidden wynds and courtyards. From Calton Hill's sweeping views to St Giles Cathedral and Holyroodhouse, each landmark reveals a layered past, ending within the storied walls of Edinburgh Castle.



EDINBURGH / ST. ANDREWS

Day 10 | Spend the day in St Andrews, where coastal scenery and storied landmarks define its enduring appeal. Visit the Old Course, widely regarded as the Home of Golf, with time to walk its iconic fairways or pause on the Swilcan Bridge. Continue to the cathedral ruins, castle, and historic university, each offering a deeper connection to the town's remarkable heritage.



EDINBURGH

Day 11 | Venture into the Scottish Highlands in expert hands, where lochs, wooded glens, and open landscapes create a striking backdrop. Visit Stirling Castle, central to Scotland's defining moments, then continue through the Trossachs and Loch Lomond National Park, where scenic beauty and quiet landscapes define the day.



EDINBURGH

Day 12 | Explore contemporary Scottish distilling at Holyrood Distillery, where an immersive visit offers insight into both whisky and gin production. Later, step into the city's lively pub culture with a curated experience through historic taverns, sampling independent whiskies and local beers while uncovering the traditions behind them.
